WHAT IS THIS PROGRAM?

The Family Self-Sufficiency Program (FSS) is a five-year intensive case management program to move affordable housing residents up and out of housing and any other subsidized program. The intent is to assist individuals in meeting their objectives by ensuring they have the tools, resources, and support needed to accomplish those goals. Goals range from participants obtaining high school diplomas/G.E.Ds. to Master's degrees, job training to secure employment, job training to secure employment, and creating a family budget for homeownership.

REQUIRED PROCEDURE FOR ALL QUALIFIED FAMILIES

- Comply with current lease agreement
- Complete program paperwork
- Complete any necessary assessments
- Develop and implement Individual Training and Services Plan
- Participate in individual and group workshops and discussions
- Seek and maintain full-time employment
- Become independent of welfare assistance for at least 12 consecutive months before the contract expires
